


# LOWER REPUBLICAN NATURAL RESOURCES DISTRICT POST HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION





## ⇒ Guidelines:

- Three scholarships are available, each worth \$1,000.00,
- Scholarships will be paid \$500.00 per semester, second semester payment requires the student complete the first semester with a 2.75 minimum grade point average,
- Applicants must have permanent residence in the Lower Republican NRD (see district map) and plan to major in a natural resources related field (i.e. forestry, park management, agronomy, agri-business, etc.)
- Scholarships are available to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year college students, applicants must attend college in Nebraska and must be registered full-time at their college,
- Applicant's essay, grades, class ranking if applicable, extracurricular activities, and letters of recommendation will be considered,
- The LRNRD Scholarship Committee will make the final award decision,
- Applications must be in the LRNRD office in Alma by April 1, 2019,
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- The scholarship may be received for 2 years only.

## How Do I Apply ?




