The Lawrence-Nelson Middle and High School will be kicking off the "Beef in Schools" Program in October 2017. "Beef in Schools" is a program started by The Nebraska Cattlemen's Association. The South Central Cattlemen Affiliate is making a starting contribution for our local school to get started. The Lawrence-Nelson FFA Alumni has taken on this challenge, and we need your help to make this program a success. The group has chosen the name "L-N Beef @ School" as their motto for the program.

This is a **COMMUNITY PROJECT** for rural and city dwellers alike. All donations will be tax deductible, whether the donation is cash or live beef.

"L-N Beef @ School" is looking for live beef to be donated to the program and/or a monetary donation for processing. Six to eight beef will be needed per year for **your children, grandchildren** and **youth** of the communities.

The beef will be processed (with state stipulations) into stew meat, hamburger and roast to be served twice a week. Live beef donors will only need to contribute beef every 4 to 5 years, if we all pitch in and do our part.
